I. Literature:

- ❖ Students should know the **genre** of the text (Informational Text), and please note that it must be spelled correctly.
- ❖ Students will be asked to answer questions on a given paragraph like:
Describe, explain, find a word that means .., and direct questions. Also, they will be asked to find out a pronoun reference.
- ❖ Students should study the comprehension sheets related to the story.

II. Unseen passage

Describe, explain, and direct questions.

(the Worksheet is an example and students will be given a **different** passage in the exam)

- ❖ Students will be asked to use correct simple present verbs to complete sentences.
