

Grade 3 – Second Speaking Assessment

Dear Parents,

We hope this message finds you well. We would like to inform you that your child's second speaking assessment will take place during the first session next week (October 19–23).

For this assessment, each student will prepare a one-minute presentation on the topic:



“If I Had a Superpower”



Students Should:

1. **Choose one superpower**
(For example: flying, invisibility, mind reading, strength...)
2. **Say what their superpower is**
“If I had a superpower, I would choose flying.”
3. **Explain what they can do with it**
“I can fly high in the sky and travel around the world.”
4. **Explain why they want it**
“I want this power because I love adventure and helping others.”
5. **Say how they will use it to help others or the world**
“I would fly to save people in danger or bring food to the poor.”

*Note: Students will be asked **critical thinking** questions after their presentation. To use their own words and share their personal thoughts and opinions naturally, **not memorized answers**.

* Reminder: Use these helpful vocabulary words that we discussed in class in your assessment/presentation:

Vocabulary

Word	Simple Meaning	Example Sentence
Invisibility(n)	The power to not be seen	<i>I can be invisible and sneak anywhere!</i>
Teleportation (n)	The power to go anywhere quickly	<i>I can teleport to school in one second!</i>
Strength (n)	The power to lift or move heavy things	<i>I can lift a car with my strong hands!</i>
Flexibility (n)	The power to bend your body easily	<i>I can twist and move like rubber!</i>

Word	Simple Meaning	Example Sentence
Lightning (n)	The power to move or attack with electricity	<i>I can shoot lightning from my hands!</i>
Mind reading (n)	Understanding what people are thinking.	<i>I wish I had mind reading so I could know what my friends are thinking.</i>
Flying (n)	Moving or traveling in the sky like a bird.	<i>I want the power of flying so I can go anywhere quickly.</i>
Talking to animals (n)	Understanding and speaking with animals.	<i>With the power of talking to animals, I could ask my cat how she feels.</i>

Sample Questions for Students

- If you had teleportation, where is the first place you would go, and how would it change your life? Explain
- If you could combine two superpowers, which would they be and why?
- If you had teleportation, where is the first place you would go, and how would it change your life? Explain
- If you could have **flying and mind reading**, how could these powers make life easier for you or others? Explain.
- You are creating a superhero team. Each member must have one of these powers: **invisibility, teleportation, super strength, mind reading, flying, flexibility, talking to animals**. Which power would you choose for yourself and how would your team work together? Explain.
