1. What is a habitat?

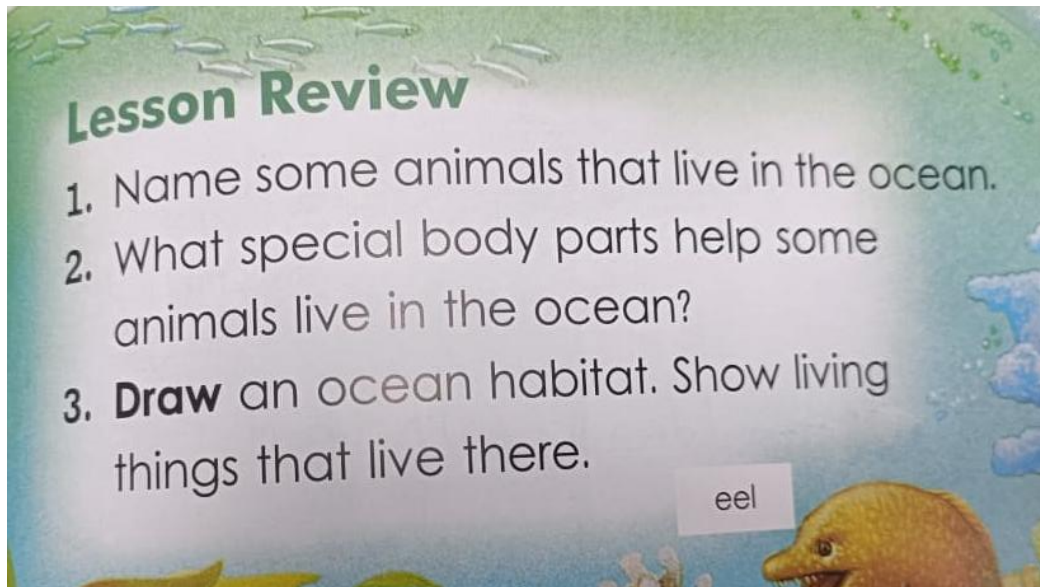
A habitat is a place where plants and animals live.
