


poachers	noun	People who hunt animals illegally	Poachers hunt animals even when it's not allowed.	
endangered	adjective	At risk of disappearing or becoming extinct	Tigers are endangered animals.	<p><b>Endangered Animals</b></p>  <p>The infographic is divided into two sections: 'World's Most Endangered Animals' and 'Other Endangered Animals'. The first section includes 15 animals: Arabian Leopard, Axolotl, Black-footed Ferret, Sunda Island Tiger, White-Cheeked Spider Monkey, California Condor, Hawaiian Monk Seal, Javan Rhinoceros, North Atlantic Right Whale, Blue-throated Macaw, Tooth-billed Pigeon, Tamaraw, Philippine Eagle, Whooping Crane, Tapanuli Orangutan, and Siberian Tiger. <b>captured</b>	verb (past)	Caught and kept something or someone	The zoo captured the lion to protect it.	
<b>banned</b>	verb (past)	Not allowed or stopped by law or rule	Smoking was banned in public places.	
<b>adopt</b>	verb	To take and care for something or someone as your own	They want to adopt a puppy from the shelter.	
<b>volunteer</b>	noun / verb	A person who helps without getting paid	I volunteer at the animal shelter on weekends.

<b>encounter</b>	verb	To meet someone or something unexpectedly	We may encounter wild animals in the forest.	
<b>recover</b>	verb	To get better after being sick or hurt	The bird will recover after getting medicine.
