Sunday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025, I need to review the following:

✓ Fiction vs Nonfiction

Students should recognize the **differences** between fictional texts and nonfictional texts. They should be able to **decide** if a text is a work of fiction or nonfiction and give **reasons** to support their answers.

✓ Genre: Folktale (booklet)

Students should know that "Stone Soup" is a folktale. They should also be able to identify the elements of a folktale.

- ✚ **Setting** (where and when the story happens)
- ✚ **Characters** (people, animals, or magical beings)
- ✚ **Conflict** (the main problem)
- ✚ **Plot** (what happens in the story)
- ✚ **Theme** (the big idea or message)
- ✚ **Repetition** (things happen in threes or repeat)
- ✚ **Moral** (the lesson we learn from the story)

✓ Reading Skill: Literary elements (booklet)

Students should be able to **identify** characters setting, plot, climax, conflict and resolution in any text.

✓ Stone Soup pages 28 - 33

Read the selection carefully and make sure you understand it well.

Review the comprehension questions.

Students should be able to identify the main ideas in the text. Students should also be able to identify story elements in the text.

✓ Vocabulary: (Vocabulary List in the booklet + pages 24-25-26 in SB + words in the footnotes)

+Students should be able to

- identify the part of speech of each word
- recognize the meaning of each word and be able to express it in English
- use each word in a complete sentence that shows the meaning of the word using correct grammar and spelling.

✓ Grammar: Simple past(booklet)+Pages 36+37 and 52+53

Students should be able to

- use simple past correctly
- spell the past form correctly
- recognize the regular and irregular past form
- use the correct spelling rules for regular past form
