

English Project: **Traditional Games and Shared Human Values – GRADE 7**

***Project Question:**

What do traditional games from different cultures reveal about shared human values, and how can we reimagine these games to engage today's generation while respecting their cultural roots?

***Project Instructions:**

1. Research:

- Choose **one or two traditional games** from any culture (your own or another).
- Find out their **origins, rules, materials used**, and **the values or lessons** they teach (e.g., teamwork, fairness, creativity, respect).

2. Analyze:

- Explain what **human values** these games reveal (such as cooperation, respect, honesty, or problem-solving).
- Compare the games to show what people across different cultures have in common.

3. Reimagine:

- Think of how you could **adapt or modernize one traditional game to make it appealing to today's generation** (for example, by using technology, new materials, or creative twists).
- Describe your new version clearly or create a **visual model/poster/video demo**.

4. Present:

- Prepare a short **oral or visual presentation (2–3 minutes)** to share your findings and your reimaged game idea with the class.
- Be ready to explain how your version keeps the **spirit and values** of the original game alive.
