Informative writing is a type of writing that **gives facts and information** about a topic. Its goal is to **teach or explain** something to the reader, not to share opinions or tell a story.

Informative writing parts:

It usually includes:

1. **An introduction** - tells what the topic is.
2. **Facts and details** - give clear information.
3. **A conclusion** - sums up what was learned.

Here are some **simple rules for writing a title:**

1. **Capitalize important words** - The first and last words, and all main words, should start with a capital letter.
 - Example: *My Favorite Animal* ✓
 - not *my favorite animal* ✗
2. **Keep it short** - A title should be only a few words, not a full sentence.
3. **Make it clear** - It should tell what your writing is about.
 - Example: *Life in Amman* or *My Teacher*
4. **Do not use a period (.)** - Titles don't end with punctuation.
5. **Make it interesting** - Choose words that make people want to read your writing.
