

Writing Recipe Rules and Rubric

- Choose an eye-catching **title**:
 1. Capitalize the first letter of each word in the title.
 2. Remember the title doesn't have a verb.
 3. Never use any punctuation marks in the title.
- Add an interesting **topic sentence** at the beginning of your paragraph.
- Leave a **space** before the first sentence. (**Indentation**)
- Include at least 3 details about the topic that you're writing about.
- Use lots of **adjectives** that draw pictures in readers' minds.
- Use **cooking verbs** and **utensils** that you may use in your recipe.
- Use **time order transition words** while writing the recipe.
- End your paragraph with a **proper conclusion**.
- Use your **best handwriting**.
- Use accurate **spelling**.
- Use correct **punctuation marks** and avoid capitalization mistakes.
- Use appropriate **tense**.
